

Installation Manual Google Index Control for OXID eShop 4

Step by step integration of the extension into an existing OXID eShop system.

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License required

Install and operate the extension only with a valid Netensio license. Keep purchase and license records for support and audit cases.

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Safety Notes

To protect the availability of your production shop, install and validate the extension in a separate test environment before using it in production.

30 day trial versions stop working completely and without additional warning after the trial period. Depending on the extension this can affect the storefront or administration area.

Use trial versions only in test systems and never as the only installation in a productive shop.



Important

Do not install trial versions in production systems. Plan enough time for testing, cache clearing and rollback.



Recommendation

Create a complete file and database backup before installation, update or removal.

Installation

Welcome to the installation of your OXID eShop extension. Run the following steps in a test system first.



Legacy note

OXID 4 is no longer actively developed. This manual describes the existing legacy packages, but no new OXID 4 features are added.

- 1 Unpack the download archive and choose the matching folder `oxid_4.7.x`, `oxid_4.8.x`, `oxid_4.9.x` or `oxid_4.10.x`.
- 2 Copy the content of `copy_this` into the root directory of your OXID eShop.
- 3 For encoded packages or trial versions place the license file in `modules/netensio/net_noindex`.
- 4 Clear the shop `tmp` directory. Keep the `.htaccess` file.
- 5 Activate the module in the shop administration.

License File for Encoded Extensions

SourceGuardian and ionCube encoded Netensio extensions require a matching license file for the licensed domain in addition to the purchased license.

- After purchase, generate and download the license file for the licensed domain in the Netensio customer account at www.netensio.de.
- Place the file unchanged and without renaming it in the extension directory `modules/netensio/net_noindex`.
- Extensions licensed under an open source license do not require a license file, and no license file is provided for that license type.
- Additional domains can be licensed with reduced-price add-on licenses.



Check before activation

If your package is SourceGuardian or ionCube encoded, copy the license file to `modules/netensio/net_noindex` before activating the extension. Skip this step for open-source licensed packages.

After Installation

- Clear the shop cache and sign in to the administration again.
- Review the new selection fields on products and categories.
- Set one category or product to `noindex`, follow for testing and review the storefront source code.

After successful activation the extension adds the `netnoindex` field to `oxarticles` and `oxcategories`.



Ready to use

Indexing is controlled per record through the Meta Tag Robots field.
